

Greetings Friends and Families:

We are pleased to share the most recent updates to visitation for our Eskaton communities:

**Visitation:** Visitation to our Residential and Skilled communities remains open. Visitors are no longer required to show proof of vaccination or a negative COVID test for indoor visitation. All visitors are required to follow CDPH’s masking guidance and should continue to maintain all current infection prevention practices to continue protecting our most vulnerable population. Additional guidance may be necessary at a community if they are in outbreak status.

**Skilled Nursing Communities and Residential (RCFE) Communities:**

All employees, in both our Skilled Nursing communities and Residential Living communities, are required to have an FDA-approved COVID-19 vaccine and booster dose, or have an approved religious or medical exemption filed.

Communities continue to screen employees, visitors and residents for signs and symptoms of illness. We request that if you plan to visit and become ill, you postpone your visit until you are well.

**Affordable Housing Communities:**

Staff at our Affordable Housing communities self-screen for symptoms and comply with all local and regional requirements to mitigate the risk for COVID 19. We ask that you postpone your visit if you are showing signs or symptoms of any illness. We are following all federal, state and local health department guidelines to mitigate the risk of COVID-19. Please check with the community you are visiting for up-to-date visitation guidance.

We are grateful to partner with you in the care and well-being of your loved one(s). We consider it an honor to join in the life of each individual in our care. As always, last minute changes to visitation may occur based on current health guidelines and we appreciate your understanding and flexibility in these situations.
